CFA TANKER UPGRADES TO ROLL OUT BY 2025

The Victorian Minister for Emergency Services has announced that every single Country Fire Authority ultralight tanker in the state will be upgraded or replaced "by the end of the year." The existing 246 tankers will be retrofitted to include new crew protection systems including radiant heat shield curtains and compressed air foam-based fire suppressants. A further 33 new ultra-light vehicles will be added to the state's fleet.

"The ultra-light tankers make up an important part of our fleet – ensuring an agile response to grassfires and [farm paddocks] that are hard to reach when our heavier trucks can't get there," Jaclyn Symes said this week.

The additional crew protection systems have been exposed to real fire and significant testing over several years to ensure they can protect volunteers during an emergency. CFA volunteers receive training each year to ensure they are familiar with any changes in the tankers, including how to operate the crew protection systems.
