FREE POP-UP HEALTH CLINIC **WEDNESDAY 7 AUG**

A fully bulk-billed pop-up health clinic will be open on Wednesday at Pomonal Community Hall this week from 10am - 5pm.

Free immunisations (flu, shingles, pneumonia) are available between 11am and noon, while free blood pressure and blood sugar checks are available all day. Cervical screening self-collection kits will also be available.

POMONAL RECOVERY CENTRE **HOURS UPDATE**

POMONAL TRANSFER STATION UPDATE

Pomonal Transfer Station has resumed normal operating hours, and fees and charges are still being waived for Pomonal residents until further notice.

Opening hours are:

Scrap metal is now being taken at Pomonal Transfer Station, but is limited to a maximum of three cubic metres.

POMONAL REBUILD TENDER OPENED BY COUNCIL

After securing a Bushfire Hazard Landscape Assessment for the Pomonal area, Council have now issued a callout for qualified bushfire consultants. These specialists are invited to register their interest by tender in joining a group of 'preferred contractors', ultimately forming a panel which will serve as an easily-accessed resource for Pomonal residents seeking fire risk assessment to assist in rebuilding homes.

Community members will be able to inform Council of their preferred consultant from the assembled panel, and Council will engage the contractor, streamlining the process towards rebuilding homes for fire-affected residents.
