## **TOP TIPS TO AVOID ANIMAL COLLISIONS**

Pomonal CFA have issued an informative bulletin about how to avoid vehicle collisions with wildlife.

They recommend slowing down at dusk and dawn (when wildlife tends to cross roads more often), and in areas where signs warn of wildlife or where shrubs block your roadside view. Kangaroos often travel in groups; if one crosses in front of you, others may follow. They also often travel at speed and cannot change direction quickly, so stay alert.

Avoid distractions when driving in high risk areas, and be sure to maintain your lights and horn - and keep your windscreen clean.

If wildlife crosses the path of your vehicle, brake hard but do not swerve, or you may lose control of your vehicle.

The golden rule is to slow down, which gives you the best chance of avoiding accidents.
