BUSHFIRE RECOVERY WELLBEING SESSIONS AT **POMONAL HALL**

Pomonal Community Resilience Group has organised two bushfire recovery sessions to be held on Wednesday 9 October at Pomonal Hall. Both sessions' speakers will present the same information.

"This is a good time to check how the recovery is progressing for individual households and the community," says the Group.

Each session will feature two speakers: Dr Rob Gordon and Michael Gordon. Rob is a clinical psychologist who specialises in disaster recovery and has supported many communities recover from bushfires and other major events (including Pomonal after the 2006 bushfire). Michael has worked closely with several communities who experienced natural disasters, and will facilitate the session.

Topics covered will include:

- insights from the experiences of other communities who have experienced bushfires and floods - with details of what has helped and hindered their recovery
- how to reduce distress during recovery with effective planning and preparation
- preparing for key miletones which may trigger further distress - such as the approaching fire season, elevated fire danger days during the summer, and the 12-month anniversary of the fire next year - and how to harness them to help recovery
- how to help young people process what they're experienced
- ways to take care of yourself, your family, and your community.



WORKS UNDERWAY ON TUNNEL TRACK LOOP WALK

Construction work for the Tunnel Track Loop Walk is well underway The project - part of Planning Permit PA3093 - aims to enhance the community's recreational offerings with a new and improved walking track.

The initial phase of the project will involve track-clearing works. To ensure the safety and clarity of the project, alignment and protection flagging will be marked out over the next few weeks. This will help to delineate the track's route and safeguard any environmentally sensitive areas during construction.
