DEECA PUBLISH STUBBLE BURN ADVICE

DEECA have shared some safety tips for those planning to conduct a paddock burn on their property this autumn.


PLEASE NOTE: Paddock burns are illegal without a permit during the Fire Danger Period, which extends to 1 May 2025 in our region.

Remember to protect paddock trees by slash around trees to establish an adequate fire break, and wet the area around trees before beginning your burn.

Be prepared with enough people, water and the right equipment to extinguish the fire.

Don't forget to report any concerns about the destruction of paddock trees during stubble burning to your local Council.


