LOCAL FARMERS FEATURED ON WIN NEWS, CHANNEL 10

CFA Westmere Group Officer and local farmer Pat Millear appeared on WIN News last week (26 March), to speak about the replacement of the Fire Services Property Levy with the new Emergency Services Volunteer Fund.

"We're the backbone of country Victoria, and we're doing a hell of a good job - like all the brigades and all groups are across Victoria - and it's just no reward for the effort we've put in," Millear told reporters. "To get this tax put on us for volunteer work is an absolute impost, and we're certainly not going to take it lying down."

Ararat Rural City Council Mayor Jo Armstrong also appeared in the segment, adding that the money collected doesn't go into Council's Budget, but is passed into the state treasury without any oversight on, or accountability for, how it will be spent.

Established by State Parliament in 1945, CFA now boasts 1,200 brigades run by over 5,000 operational volunteers (those who perform firefighting and emergency response work) with a further 2,400 supporting volunteers (those who perform crucial roles in fundraising, community awareness events, administration and IT, equipment maintenance and more).
