'PILLOWCASE' WORKSHOP TO HELP KIDS PREPARE



The Red Cross will be at the Pomonal Primary School on November 14 to talk to students about how to prepare for, cope with and respond to emergencies. As part of the 'Pillowcase' workshop, each child will receive a pillowcase to decorate and take home as the start of their own personal emergency kit. The sessions will also include discussions about different types of emergencies, how to stay calm, and how to seek help if needed. The workshop is supported by Ararat Rural City Council and Grampians Community Health. Students from Buangor, Maroona, Moyston and Willaura will also take part.
